Message from Admin: Empowering Parents Grant has opened!



Who is Eligible to Apply?

Idaho students K-12 are eligible regardless of whether they attend a public school, private school, or are home schooled.

What do Parents Need to Complete the Application?

- One of the following documents: US passport, government-issued State ID, driver's license, or Green Card.
- For child verification provide one of the following options: birth certificate, US passport, government-issued State ID, 1040 Federal Tax Return, or driver's license.

How are Awards Prioritized?

<u>First</u> to households with an Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) at or below \$60,000 per year. Then the AGI limit will be expanded to households earning up to \$75,000 per year, if there are any grant funds still available, the program will be available to all other eligible students on a first come first serve basis.


